



# 2010 BOY SCOUT RAILROADING MERIT BADGE DAY

## Saturday, April 17, 2010



The Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge Day will include presentations and activities that will fulfill the requirements for Boy Scouts to earn their Railroading Merit Badge. Registration for this event will include box lunch, all-day admission to Knott's Berry Farm and railroading activities. Registration is available to the first 500 participants (including leaders and guardians). To attend as a Scout, you must be an active member of a Boy Scout Troop. Adults attending must be Troop leaders or guardians of Scouts. Registrants will be provided wristbands on the day of the event that will provide them access to special venues.

### Event Schedule

**Check-in:** 8:30 - 10 a.m. (arrive anytime during this period to start the activities)

**Activities:** 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Participants will rotate through the various stations during the activities time. Details of each station will be provided at check-in. Activities to complete the Railroading Merit Badge requirements could take up to four hours. Participants are welcome to enjoy the amusement park all day on April 17. #### Station 1

Fulfills Railroading Merit Badge requirements 1, 2, 4, 5 & 6

A welcome presentation will be given by the Orange County Transportation Authority providing a brief overview of the event and educating participants about rail safety. This presentation is also open to guests of Scouts (siblings, etc.). Following the presentations, Scouts can visit informational tables to learn about different types of trains and railroad trip planning.

#### Station 2

Fulfills Railroading Merit Badge requirements 3 & 7

Participants will be given the unique opportunity to visit the Calico Railroad Roundhouse. Knott's Berry Farm staff will present information about railroading careers as well as train signals and functions. A wristband is required to take the tour.

#### Station 3

Fulfills Railroading Merit Badge requirement 8

A tour guide will take Scouts through the refurbished train cars, *The Edna* and *The Durango*. *The Edna* was the private car of the president of the railroad built in 1881, and *The Durango* is a parlor car built in 1883. A wristband is required to take the tour.

#### Station 4

Fulfills Railroading Merit Badge requirement 2

No Railroading Merit Badge Day is complete without a ride on a real train. Participants will take a roundtrip tour of the park on the Calico Railroad, one of the last year-round operating narrow gauge railroads. The Calico Railroad is open to the public.
